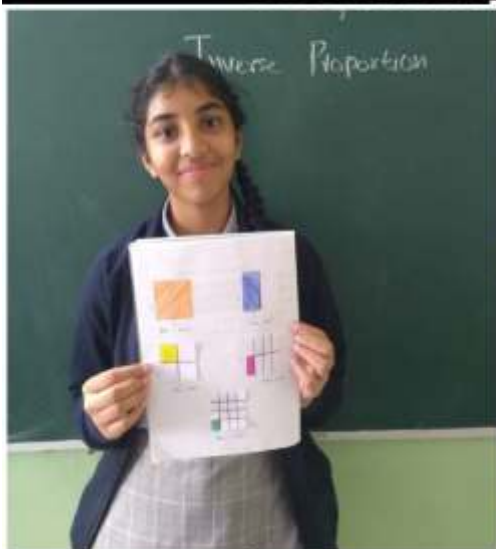

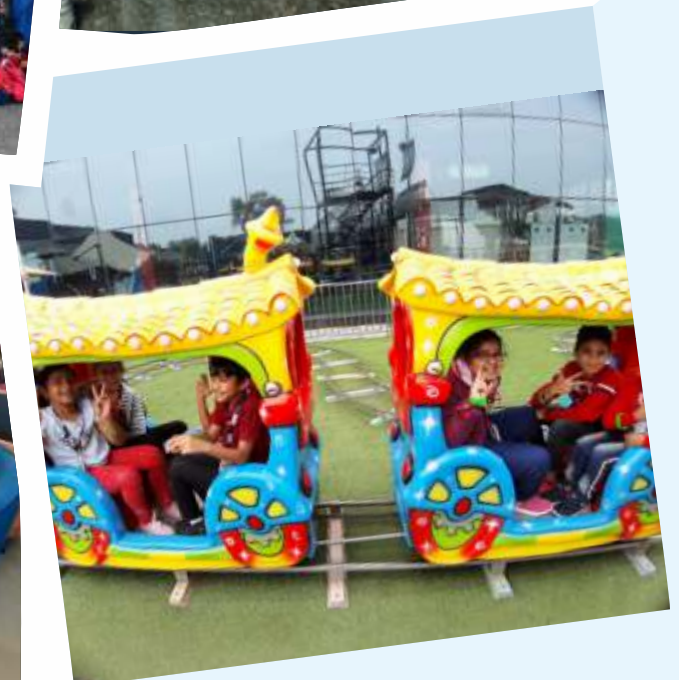

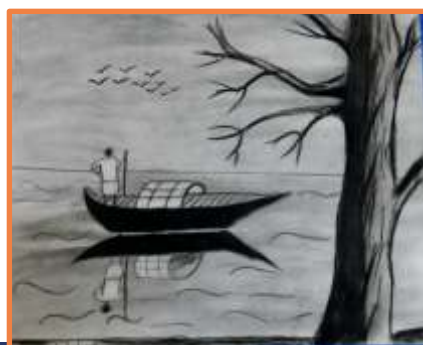

नुराज़ : आपने सेपकटकरा खेलना क्यों चुना ?

इकराम : हमें सेपकटकरा के बारे में कुछ बताइए ?

हिशाम मोहम्मद रहमत : सेपकटकरा भारत के नॉर्थ ईस्ट का प्रसिद्ध खेल है, यह खेल वॉलीबॉल, जिम्नास्टिक, फुटबॉल और बैडमिंटन का मिश्रण है। इस खेल को इंडोर हॉल में 20 गुणा 44 के आकार की जगह में सिंथेटिक फाइबर की गेंद से खेला जाता है। इसमें बॉल को पैरों से मारते हैं। हाथों का इस्तेमाल नहीं करते। जिम्नास्ट की तरह उछलकर खेलते हैं। 'सेपक' इंडोनेशियाई और मलेशियाई शब्द है जिसका अर्थ है किक मारना। 'टकरा' का मतलब है बुनी हुई बॉल।

नुराज़ : एक सेपकटकरा खिलाड़ी के रूप में आपको राष्ट्रीय स्तर तक पहुँचने में कितना समय लगा।

हिशाम मोहम्मद रहमत : राष्ट्रीय स्तर पर सफलतापूर्वक पहुँचने और दूसरा स्थान हासिल करने में मुझे लगभग दो साल लग गए। मेरा हमेशा से मानना रहा है कि सही मानसिकता एवं योजना के साथ कुछ भी हासिल किया जा सकता है लेकिन सबसे महत्वपूर्ण सही मार्गदर्शन है। इस खेल ने मुझे जीवन में आगे बढ़ने के लिए आवश्यक चीजें सिखाई हैं- जैसे दृढ़ इच्छाशक्ति होना, अनुशासित रहना, विभिन्न विकर्षणों से दूर रहते हुए आगे बढ़ते रहना। मैं हमेशा डी.एस.ई. के खेल संकाय का आभारी रहूँगा जिन्होंने मेरी छिपी प्रतिभाओं को ऊँचाई तक पहुँचाने में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान दिया है। और मुझे अपनी आंतरिक क्षमता को खोजने में मदद की है।

From prodigy to professional

ABHINANDANA: What are you pursuing now? What have you been up to recently?

REYAAN: Being someone who is in love with music, and making music - I have chosen to study music as a subject and learn everything about it. I've just been working on music day in and day out. I've also performed in Hyderabad and Delhi very recently.

ABHINANDANA: That sounds extremely interesting, but I'm curious: what was your first experience with music? How did you develop an interest in making music?

REYAAN: Growing up, I've always been interested in music. My first proper experience with music probably was when I performed for the famous RedFM Radio 93.5 in an open event. Just looking at how everybody enjoys music together and how it can affect an individual's mood made me fall in love with it even more.

ABHINANDANA: Who are your musical influences? Why?

REYAAN: A few of my musical influences are Bruno Mars, Lil Baby, The Weeknd and Aaryan Shah. They're all great artists and have had a huge impact on me as an artist.

ABHINANDANA: Coming up with anything original forms of artwork is extremely difficult and time-consuming, so I would like to ask you: what is the most difficult part about the music making process?

REYAAN: The most difficult part about making music would probably be making sure the audience understands what you're going for and what the artist really means. Multiple times I've also had a writer's-block which really slows down the process of making music for me but in recent times it's been quite easy for me to move on from it.

ABHINANDANA: What has been your biggest career highlight so far?

REYAAN: I've had multiple career highlights so far, from getting featured on the famous RollingStone India magazine, to getting my song placed at #1 on 'The Sound Of Hyderabad' playlist on Spotify.

I'd say the biggest career highlight I've had so far is having 600 people show up for my first live show and sing the lyrics to my songs with me.

ABHINANDANA: Wow, that is really a goosebumps moment. Congratulations! My next question to you is: how did being a student at DSE help you in pursuing your passion?

REYAAN: Being a student in DSE did help me pursue music. I was a part of the school choir, we kept having practice for any event we had, which helped me improve on my vocals. I also got selected for the Indian Idol Jr and Colors TV Competition through the school which further motivated me a lot.

ABHINANDANA: Could you share any anecdotes from your time as a student of DSE?

REYAAN: I remember performing the song 'Eye of the Tiger' during my music class and my music teacher at the time, Mr. Shashank had asked me if I

wanted to perform the song on stage during the assembly. I was very hesitant at first and had been denied the opportunity. After a few days, Shashank Sir told me that he had learnt the instrumental to 'Eye Of The Tiger' and would be on stage with me if I choose to perform it, to which I agreed. Fast forward to the day I performed the song on stage, it went really well and everybody loved it. The fact that Shashank Sir had learnt the song on the keyboard in a matter of days just to see me perform, and believed in me at the same time really meant a lot to me and still does.

ABHINANDANA: What advice would you give to students looking to pursue a career in music?

REYAAN: To whoever is making music or is looking to make music - I'd say 'don't give up and keep going'. I've had days where I've had a writer's block and couldn't write anything and I've also had days where I've sat back and doubted myself. Two very important things I've learnt since I started making music were - nothing beats hard work and that consistency is the key to success. I started making my own music during the first lockdown and haven't stopped since. As an artist it's also important to find your sound, to know what really works for you - be it Hip-Hop / RnB / Pop or anything. It's also very important for an artist to learn how to mix and master his tracks, which would come under the production side of music.

ABHINANDANA: That sounds like very solid advice. Thank you Reyaan for taking the time to chat with me today. I wish you all the best for your career and hope that you can achieve all that you wish for. Dreams do come true, through sheer hard work and determination. 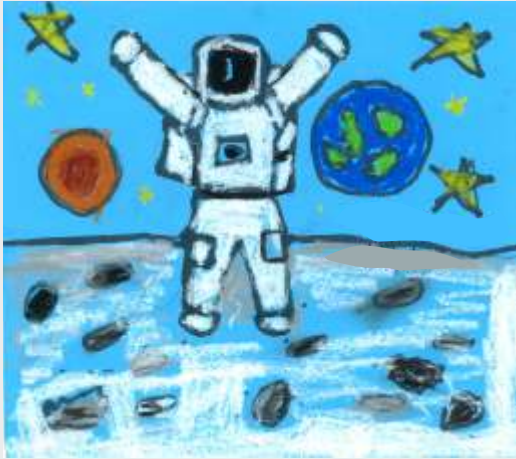

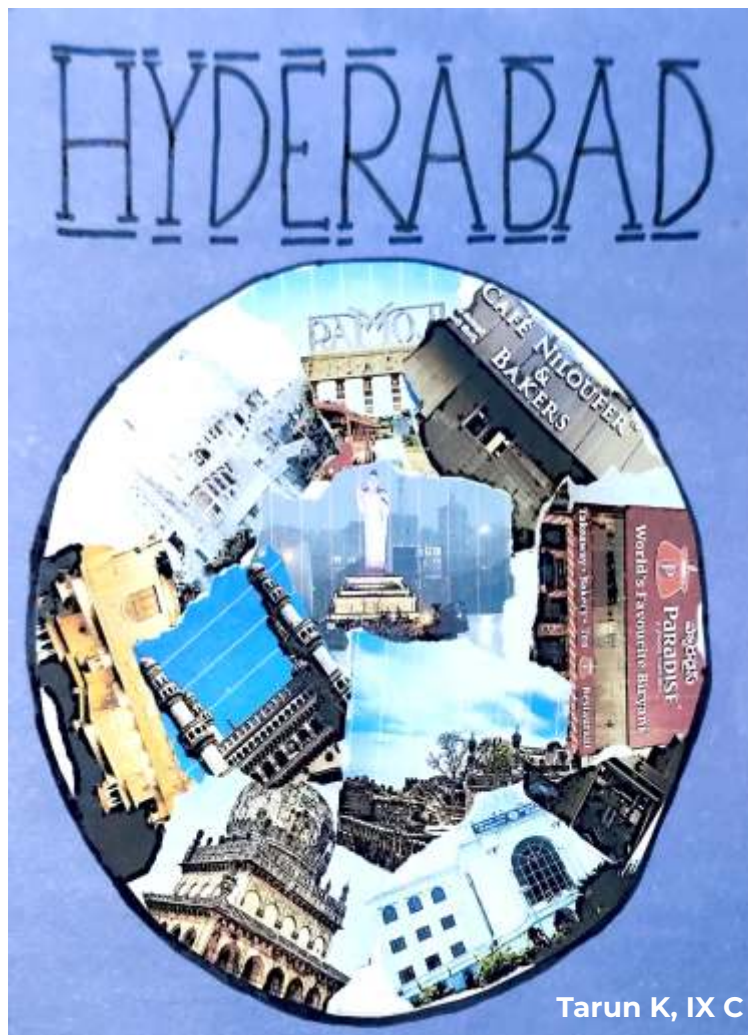

Origin of Banjara Hills

The land was first bought by Nawab Mehdi Nawaz Jung, A minister in the court of the last Nizam in 1927 who built his residency in Banjara Bhavan.

The last Nizam suggested that the area be named after the nawab, as the man responsible for its development. The nawab stated that it would only be fair to name the area after its original inhabitants, the Banjaras. The Banjara Bhavan was visited by Jawaharlal Nehru and Rabindranath Tagore as well. He wrote a wonderful poem on Banjara Hills. Road No.1 of Banjara Hills also known as Mehdi Nawaz Jung road is named in his honour. The total population was 1,50,000.

The Banjara tribe (also known as Lambadas) migrated to the Deccan from Rajasthan during Mughal emperor Shah Jahan's reign around 1,630 CE. Banjara hills is a famous place for hotels, upscale restaurants and large shopping malls. Taj Krishna, Taj Deccan and Taj Banjara are well-known Star Hotels of this area. Big shopping malls like the GVK One, City Centre, etc. are also located here.



The Plus Points of Hyderabad

Hyderabad is a city of many things – a city that has been a melting pot of varied cultures, languages, religions, cuisines and a centre for trade for many centuries. It has also evolved as a centre for employment opportunities connected to information technology. In the 1930s, Shivram Grover migrated from Peshawar, now in Pakistan, to Hyderabad and began selling fruits and dry fruits to the households of Nizam of Hyderabad and other monarchs like the Queen of England and Turkey's Ottomans.
- In no time, his products became so popular that Shivram set up a small stall. Today, Vijay Grover, the third generation owner, is managing the extremely popular outlet.
- "Ours was the first store that was started at MJ Market. Before that, it was near Karachi Bakery. When the MJ Market was constructed, we were perhaps the first occupants there. Besides Nizams, we used to sell to Jagirdar's College, now Hyderabad Public School, and others," he says. They used to procure fruits from across the country while figs, raisins, and other dry fruits were from Afghanistan.
- Vijay initially didn't plan to enter the business but shifted gears on realising a bigger role in modernising his family business.

Sanjay Thumma (born 26 April 1970) popularly known as Vah-Chef, is an Indian celebrity chef, entrepreneur, restaurateur and television personality. He is the founder of the cooking website, vahrehvah.com. He is especially popular among the Indie-expatriate communities in mainland India.

He became known for his online recipe channel on YouTube, which he started in 2007, with over 750 million views. He was one of the three judges in the first season of Master Chef India – Telugu.

Early life

Sanjay Thumma was born in Hyderabad. His interest in the kitchen began when he was just 7 years old. His mother would engage him in the kitchen so that he would not annoy his siblings. His first dishes were dosa and scrambled eggs. His desire to cook increased when his

mother was bedridden with a temporary illness and he had to cook for himself. He eventually went on to get his diploma in Hotel Management from IHM Hyderabad. He is married to Ragini, who is also a chef, with whom he has a son.

Career

Thumma opened his first restaurant, Sizzle India, in Chicago in 1998. Over the next seven years, he opened three more. He eventually sold his restaurants as he felt that as a chef he hardly got a chance to cook. In September 2007, he set up a studio in Chicago and started recording his first 150 recipes, which he posted on YouTube on his channel VahChef, which soon becoming a sensation, and each video reaching over a million views. His channel went on to become viral and gained a large following among Indian communities all over the world. His channel crossed 750 million views with 2.3 million subscribers and more than 2,000 videos. He adds 10 to 12 new videos each month, with thousands of views within hours. He moved back to India in 2008 with his family and launched his own website, vahrehvah.com. In 2014, his channel had 1.45 million subscribers. As of June 2021, his YouTube channel has 2.39 million subscribers.

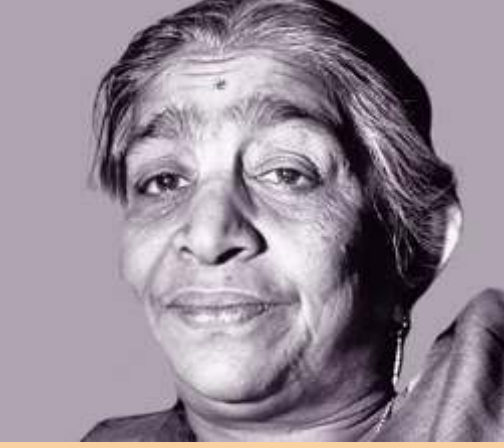

సరోజినీ నాయుడు 1879 ఫిబ్రవరి 13వ తేదీన హైదరాబాదులో జన్మించింది. ఈమె తండ్రి పేరు అఘోర నాథ చటోపాధ్యాయ. తల్లి పేరు వరదా సుందరీ దేవి. ఈమె తన 13వ ఏట “సరోవరి రాణి” అనే పద్య రచన చేసింది. నిజాం నవాబు ఈమెలో ఉన్న ప్రతిభను గమనించి ఉన్నత చదువులకై విదేశాలకు పంపించాడు. అంతేగాదు తన చదువు కొరకు ప్రతి సంవత్సరం 4200 రూపాయలు వేతనంగా ఇచ్చాడు. సరోజినీ దేవి లండన్ కింగ్ కళాశాలలో మరియు గిర్టిన్ కళాశాలలోను విద్యాభ్యయనం చేసింది. ఈమెకు ఉన్న కవితా లక్షణాల కారణంగా ఈమెను “నైటింగేల్ ఆఫ్ ఇండియా (భారత కోకిల)” అని పిలుస్తారు. ఈమె 1925లో దేశ ప్రజలకు సేవ చేసినందుకు గాను అప్పటి కాంగ్రెస్ కు అధ్యక్షురాలు అయ్యింది. 1947 లో ఉత్తర ప్రదేశ్ కు మొట్ట మొదటి మహిళా గవర్నర్ గా పని చేసింది. 1949 మార్చి 2న సరోజినీ నాయుడు మరణించింది.

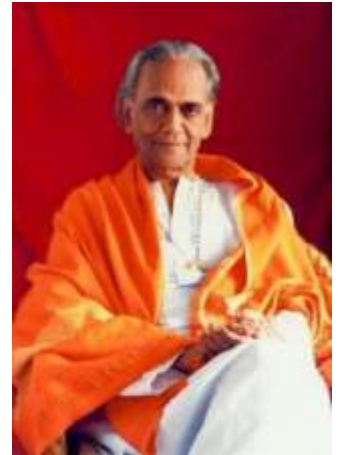

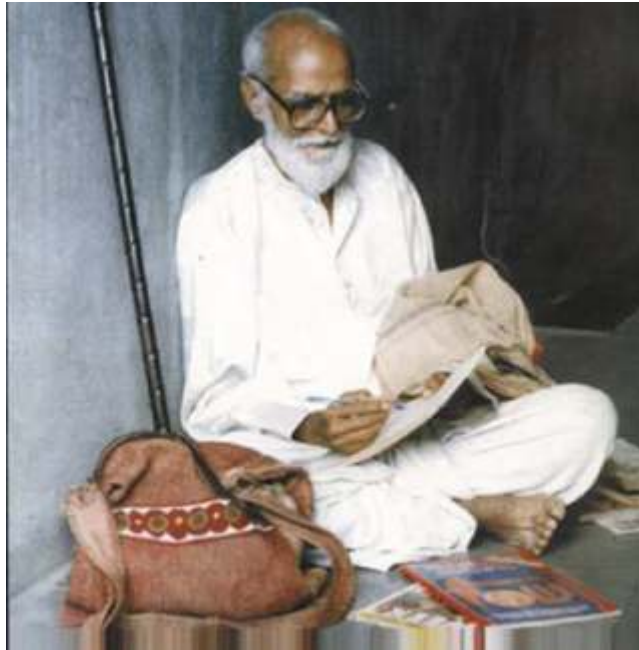
Nischal Narayanam is the youngest Double Guinness World Record holder and the

Kaloji Narayana Rao, né le 9 septembre 1914, était un poète indien, combattant de la liberté, antifasciste et militant politique de Telangana.

Il était aussi connu sous le nom de Kalanna, Praja Kavi

Il est né dans le village de Rattihalli dans le quartier de Bijapur, Karnataka. Sa mère Ramabayamma était originaire du Karnataka. Son père Kaloji Rangarao est originaire du Maharashtra. Son frère aîné, Kaloji Rameshwar Rao, un poète urdu, a joué un rôle essentiel dans la formation de sa personnalité. Kaloji a terminé ses études primaires à Madikonda et ses études supérieures à Warangal et Hyderabad. Kaloji est polyglotte. Bien qu'il ait étudié le télugu dès son plus jeune âge, il a également écrit de la poésie en marathi, kannada, hindi et urdu. M. Kaloji a épousé Rukmini Bai en 1940

Durant ses années d'études, il est profondément influencé et participé aux mouvements populaires de l'époque, comme le mouvement Arya Samaj, notamment dans le domaine des droits civiques. Il a également été impliqué dans les activités d'Andhra Maha Sabha depuis sa formation en 1934 et fait partie des mouvements Satyagraha, Osmania University Vandemataram, State Congress, Andhra Maha Sabha (Telangana) . Considéré par beaucoup comme un combattant

de la liberté, il faisait partie du mouvement de liberté dans l'État d'Hyderabad et a été emprisonné sous le Nizam.

En septembre 2014, le gouvernement de Telangana, en son honneur, a nommé l'Université de médecine Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences.

En 1992, il a reçu un doctorat honorifique de l'Université de Kakatiya

Il a reçu le Padma Vibhushan en 1992. Le gouvernement Telangana a honoré l'anniversaire de Kaloji en tant que Journée de la langue Telangana.

Kaloji Narayanan Rao est décédé le 13 novembre 2002. Il avait fait don de son corps pour la recherche au Kakatiya Medical College de Warangal

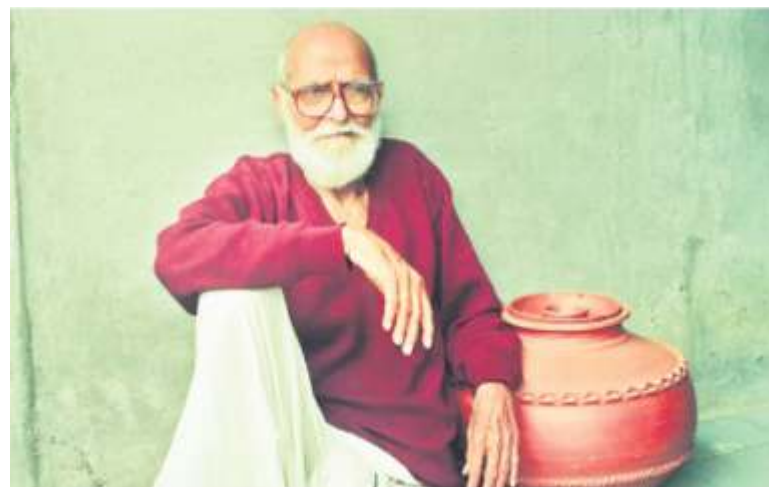

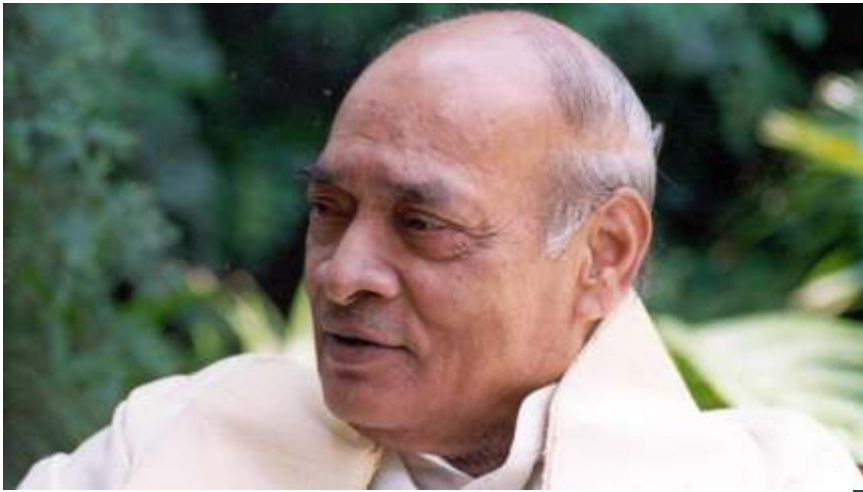

Biographie de P. V. Narasimha Rao, personnalité célèbre de Telangana

Pamulaparthi Venkata Narasimha Rao populairement connu sous le nom de P.V. Narasimha Rao était un avocat, homme d'État et homme politique indien qui a été le 9e Premier ministre de l'Inde du 21 juin 1991 au 16 mai 1996. Il est connu pour avoir introduit diverses réformes libérales dans l'économie indienne.

Il est né le 28 juin 1921 à Laknepalli, Hyderabad, Inde (aujourd'hui Telangana) et est décédé le 23 décembre 2004 (à 83 ans) à New Delhi, Inde. Il est né dans une famille Telugu Brahmane et a été adopté alors qu'il n'avait que trois ans et amené à Vangara, un village de l'actuel Telangana. PV Narasimha Rao a reçu son éducation formelle sous la supervision de son parent dans le village de Katkuru dans le district de Karimnagar. Par la suite, il est diplômé de l'Université d'Osmania à Hyderabad et a obtenu une maîtrise en droit de l'Université de Bombay et de l'Université de Nagpur.

PV Narasimha Rao, qui a réalisé sa responsabilité pour la société, a été impliqué dans le mouvement de liberté de l'Inde qui a commencé contre les Britanniques au début des années 1930. Il a été activement impliqué dans le mouvement Vande Mataram qui a commencé à Hyderabad dans les années 1930.

Il convient de noter que Narasimha Rao a été arrêté à plusieurs reprises par le gouvernement britannique pour sa voix forte contre le colonialisme britannique. Il a particulièrement réussi à sensibiliser le public contre le colonialisme en raison de sa maîtrise de plusieurs langues.

PV Narasimha Rao était un combattant actif de la liberté pendant le mouvement d'indépendance de l'Inde. Après l'indépendance de l'Inde, il devient

membre du Congrès National indien et s'implique directement dans l'arène politique.

De 1957 à 1977, Narasimha Rao a été élu membre de l'Assemblée législative de l'État d'Andhra Pradesh. De manière significative, en 1971, il a pris la relève en tant que ministre en chef de l'Andhra Pradesh et a occupé le poste de ministre en chef jusqu'en 1973. De manière significative, P.V. Narasimha Rao avait également été ministre dans divers portefeuilles d'État avant de devenir ministre en chef. Il a été ministre du droit et de l'information dans le gouvernement de l'Andhra Pradesh de 1962 à 1964, ministre du droit, ministre de la santé et de la médecine de 1964 à 1967 et ministre de l'éducation de 1968 à 1971..

PV Narasimha Rao, un politicien notable de la politique indienne, sera toujours mentionné parmi la nouvelle génération en raison de ses compétences, de ses qualités talentueuses, de son élégance et de sa forte personnalité, même s'il a été dans diverses controverses dans sa vie politique.

Sa femme est Anupama Nadella et il a 2 filles et 1 fils. Nadella a étudié à l'école publique d'Hyderabad, Begumpet avant d'obtenir un baccalauréat en génie électrique du Manipal Institute of Technology du Karnataka en 1988. Nadella s'est ensuite rendue aux États-Unis pour étudier pour faire la Maîtrise en informatique à l'Université du Wisconsin-Milwaukee, obtenant son diplôme en 1990. Plus tard, il a obtenu un MBA de la Booth School of Business de l'Université de Chicago en 1997.

Nadella a travaillé comme vice-président principale de la Recherche et du Développement (R&D) pour la division des services en ligne et vice-président de la division Microsoft Business. En 2019, Nadella a été nommée Personnalité de l'année par le Financial Times et Homme d'affaires de l'année par le magazine Fortune. En 2020, Nadella a été reconnue comme l'icône mondiale des affaires indiennes aux India Business Leader Awards de CNBC-TV18 à Mumbai. En 2022, Nadella a reçu Padma Bhushan, la troisième plus haute distinction civile en Inde par le gouvernement indien.

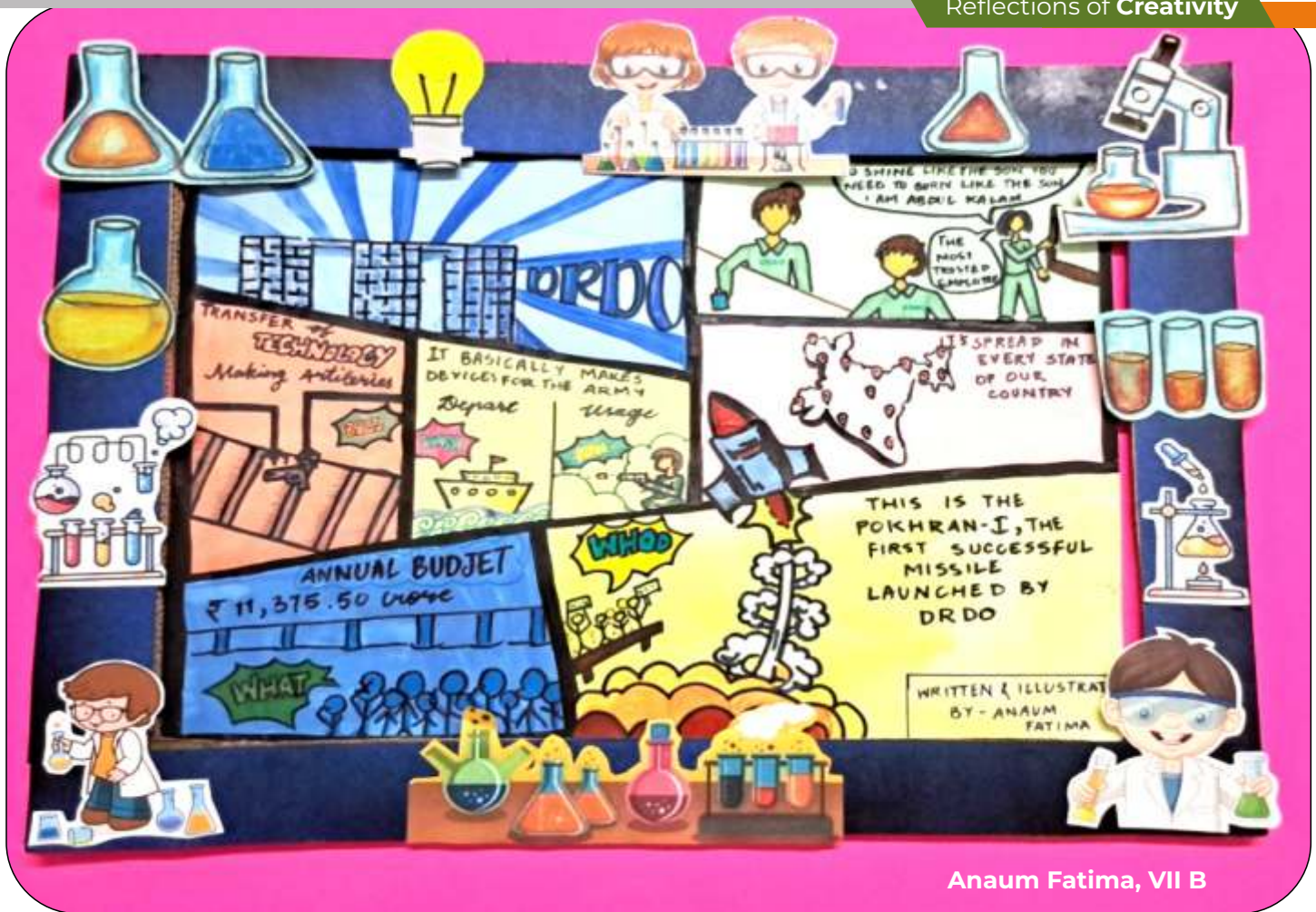
IITH has cultivated an idea-based ecosystem of learning and development based on innovation by encouraging students to work on their own projects, the best of which would receive up to one lakh in funding.

Out of the 30 industry-ready innovations that were proudly showcased at IIT's Innovation Day, the most notable ones are:

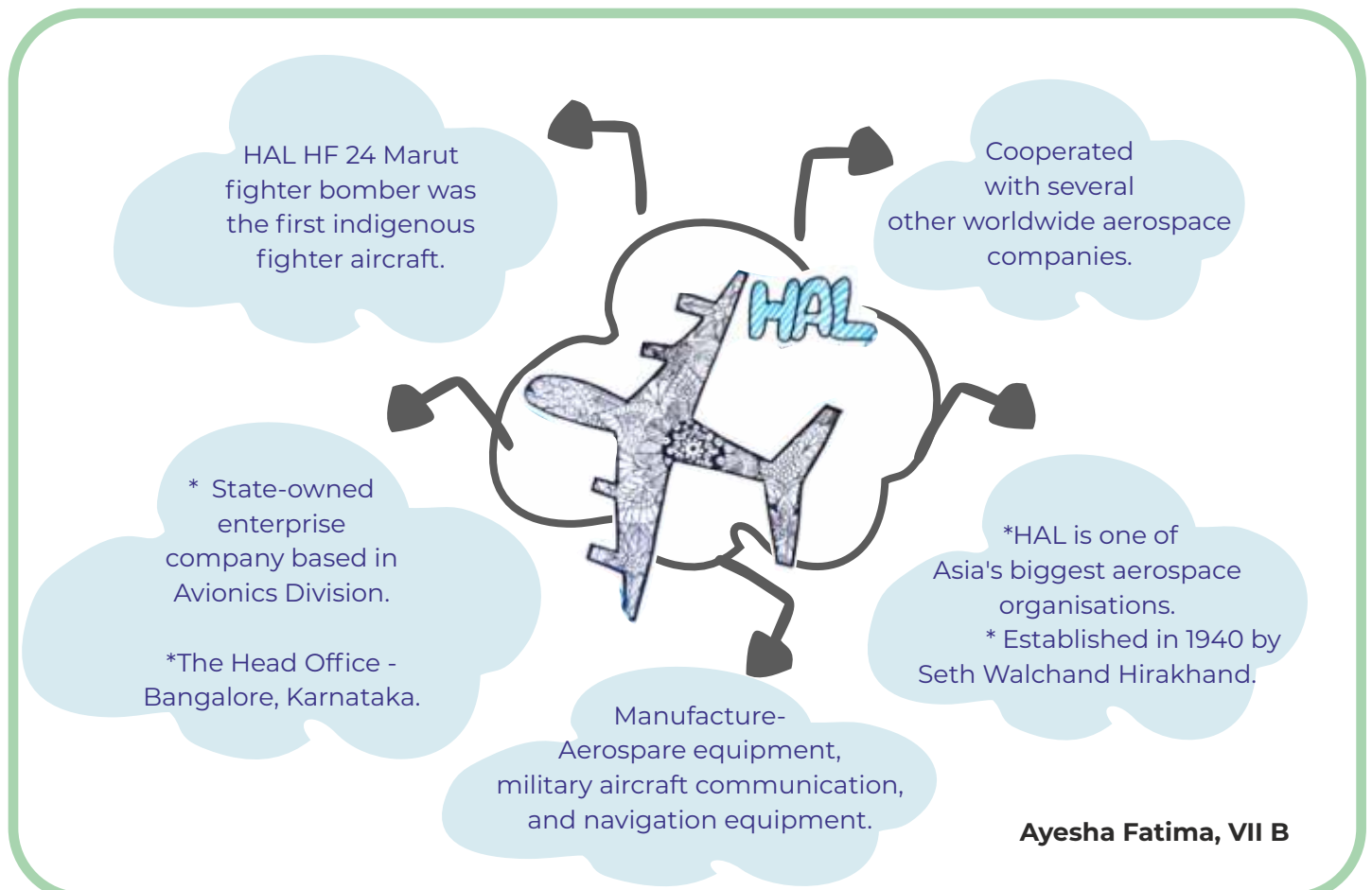
- Disabled battery-powered attachments to convert regular wheelchairs into motorised ones

- The system of Vayu air purifier captures and disinfects all the pathogens with a UVC lamp and HEPA filter technology to remove 99.97% airborne particles.



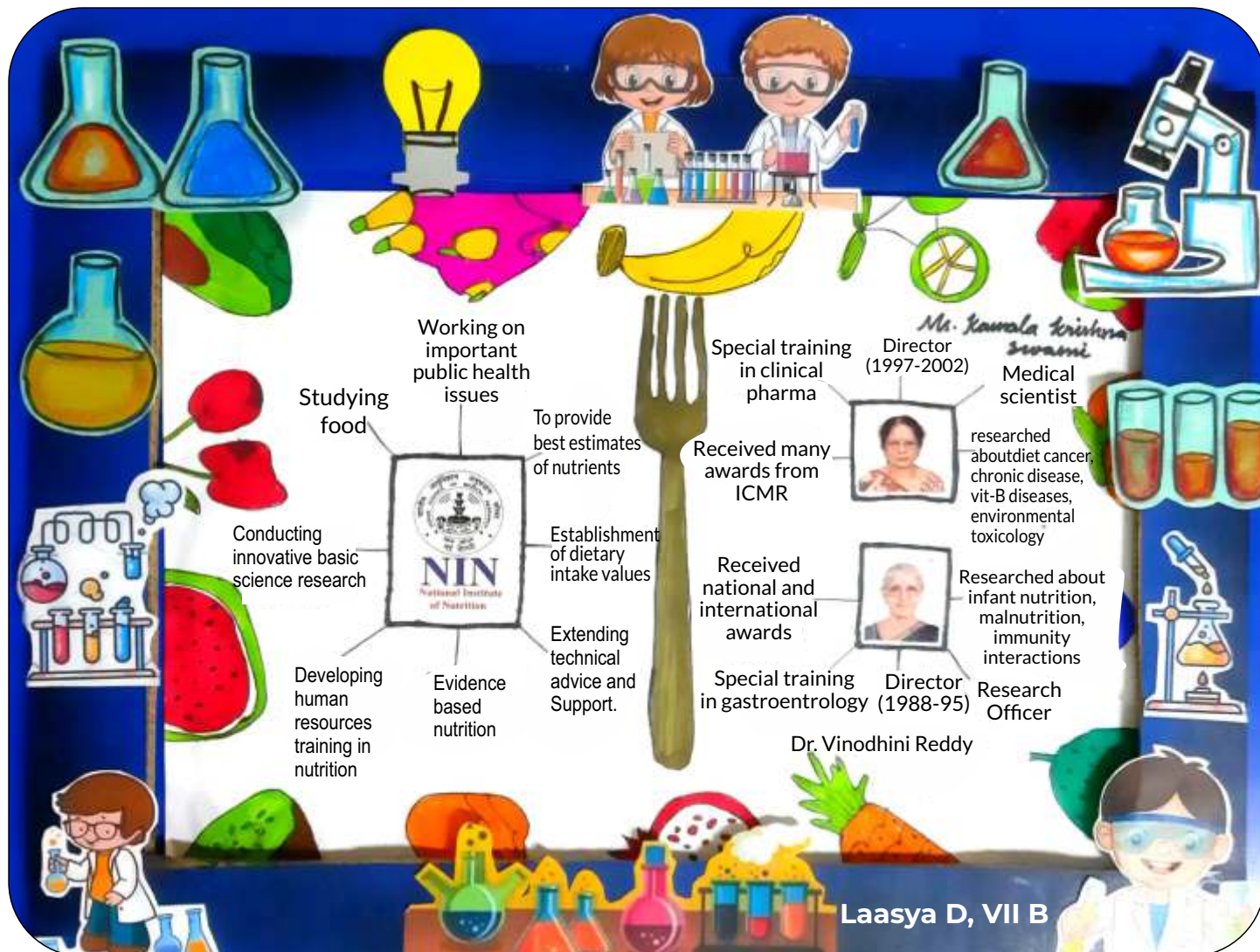

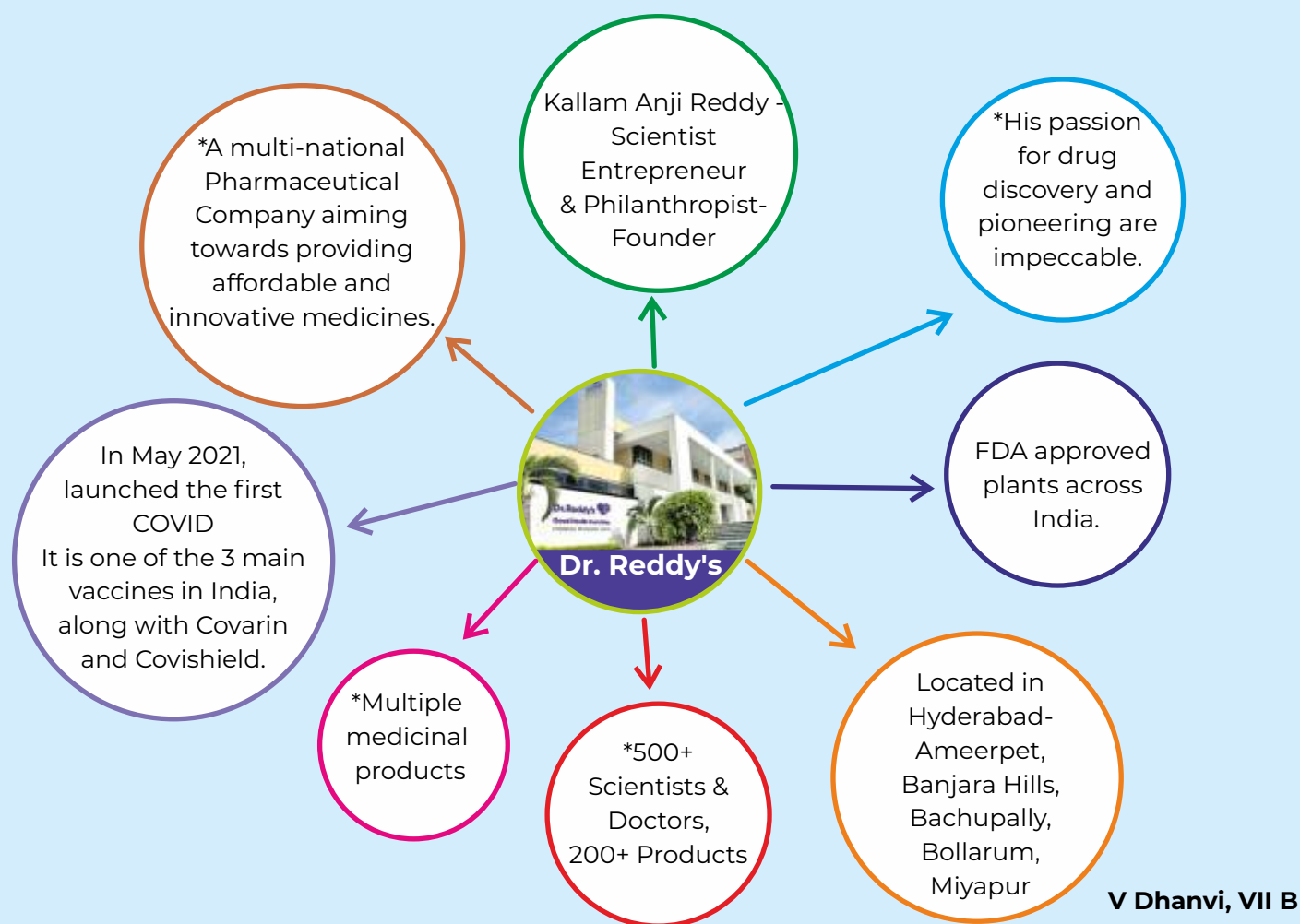

International Crops Research Institute for the Semi- Arid Tropics (ICRISAT)

Interviewer – Dr. Jacqueline, thank you for your time to interact with us. Can you please tell us the objectives of ICRISAT and also, I would like to know in which other countries is ICRISAT active?

Response: Hi, International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics also known as (ICRISAT) is an organisation which conducts agricultural research for developments in drylands of Asia and Sub-Saharan Africa.

Typically the Semi-Arid or dryland tropics cover a vast area, supporting the livelihood of over 2 billion people, and 644 million people among the poorest of the poor in the world. It helps poor people to overcome poverty, hunger and degraded environment by guiding and helping them to use systematic agricultural practices..

Interviewer – This is a highly inspiring work, thank you for explaining. Can you please inform us about what was the parent organisation of ICRISAT, and who are the active members now.

Response: The parent organization is called “The Consortium of International Agriculture Research Centre (CGIAR)”. Some of the key members in our organization includes Prof. Prabhu Pingali, Dr. Arvind Kumar, Dr. Ramadjita Tabo, and Shri Sanjay Agarwal.

Interviewer - Can you please tell us about the journey of your organization?

Response: It was founded in 1972 by a consortium of organisations convened by the Ford and Rockefeller Foundations. The charter was signed by the “Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO)” which is a specialized agency of the United Nations (UN) leading international efforts particularly to defeat hunger, and The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) which is also a UNO agency tasked with supporting countries eliminate overall poverty and achieve sustainable economic growth and human development.

Interviewer – This is great to know. Request you to please explain more about these Semi –Arid Tropics?

Response: The Semi-Arid Tropical area is characterized as a highly variable region, with low to medium rainfall and poor soil conditions. This is also further characterized by the region with lack of proper irrigation. Besides in this region, there is unpredictable weather, long dry seasons, inconsistent rainfall, and soils that are poor in nutrients.

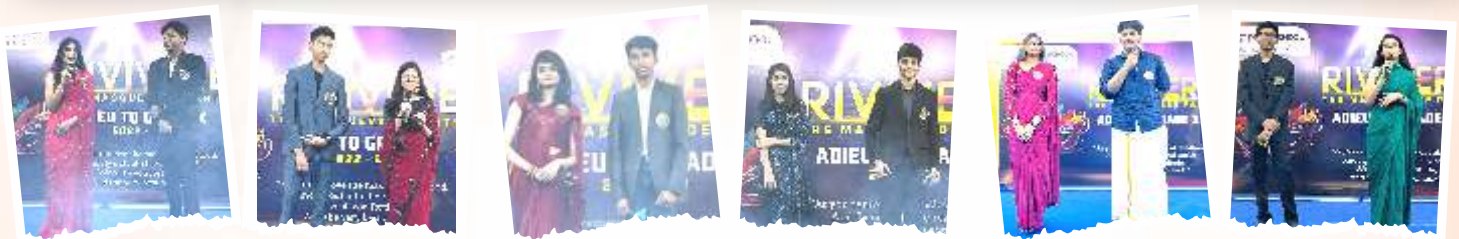

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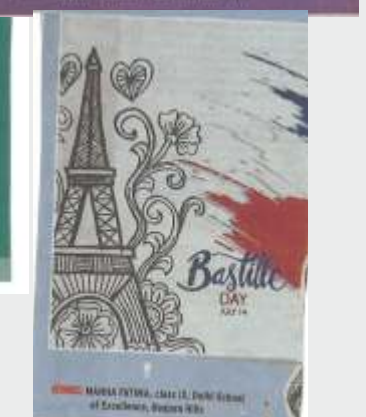
