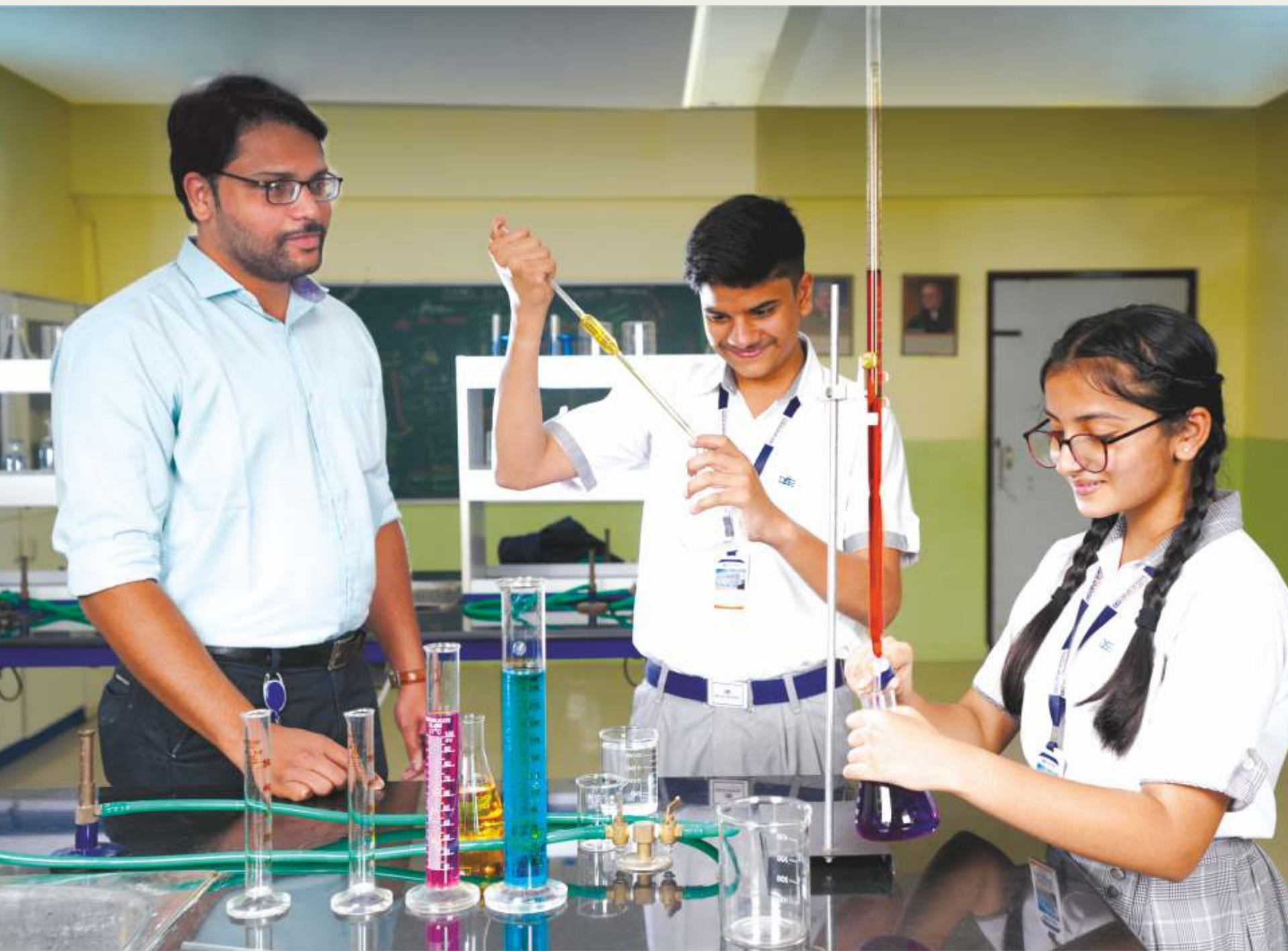
Visual & Performing Arts
